# Principals Report I Ms. Catherwood

- April 14 is a Pro D Day
- April 15 and 18 there is no school due to the Easter long weekend.

- May 3 is early dismissal for collaboration day with 5 schools. The school will be having a guest speaker; David Bouchard will be speaking on Indigenous issues.
- May 13 is multiples day, dress alike with your friends.
- The Grade 5s are asking for an 80's day, the day hasn't been set yet, but this is coming. There will be music and everyone will be encouraged to dress in 80's clothes.
- The Grade 5 leaving ceremony will be June 24 and most likely parents will be allowed to come, but just parents and grade 5 students; no other guests. PAC is doing a special lunch that day. The school is planning a Grade 5 field trip to Wild Play.
- Fun Lunch the orders are open for spring.
- Rapid Antigen tests are here and if you haven't been able to pick up please pick up and spread the word that they are available to those who want them.
- Question to the Treasurer: Is there a deadline for the receipts for classroom funds or field funds? Tina responded that June 15 is the deadline.
- The school has ordered 2 ball pumps and a box set of 48 books written by First Nations authors. The school has also ordered a diversity book set curated by Adrian Geer. These sets include classroom resources, information on what to do with the sets, and high-quality book sets. The price of the diversity book set is higher than expected. The school greatly appreciates these purchases.
