## School Trustee Report I Marc Andres

- District is committed to SOGI and ensuring students and staff feel safe and included in their school communities, please bring any concerns forward.
- Queensborough bus pilot funded through June 2026
- NWSS cooling project has commenced, should be installed by May/ June 2025
  - o 1350 students taking summer school this year, continuing to grow
- Facilities requests to the Ministry of Education
  - o upgrade HVAC at multiple sites
  - o cooling in portables, upgrading electrical
  - o carbon neutral heating/ cooling program (5 sites including Herbert Spencer)
  - o \$195,000 upgrade to playgrounds at 3 sites
- Looking forward to the approach our new superintendent is bringing to the district
- Kindergarten gradual entry was adjusted this year, board is reviewing the success rate
- Motions brought forward to the Ministry of Education
  - o district is advocating to reimburse school districts for planning for major capital projects
  - fully fund portable installation to accommodate enrollment growth
  - review of 22nd St planned community not allocating a site for school needs due to population growth
